Translation of documents:

If original documents (certificates, transcripts, etc.) are not in Slovene language, they must be accompanied by a translation into Slovene language. Selected degree students will have to provide certified translations into Slovene language during the application process at the University of Maribor.

Degree seeking students:

Please have in mind that only a limited number of applicants can be admitted to the degree programmes. If you apply, make sure your application holds all the necessary documents and your prior education matches the programme you apply to.

Visa and residence permit:

Once you are selected as JoinEU SEE scholar, you will receive Invitation letter from University of Maribor. Please get in touch with Slovenian Embassy in your country as soon as possible. Procedure for getting visa/residence permit lasts approximately 5 or more weeks.
